The present rising costs of material and labour are making it very difficult for us to manufacture our products at a pre-war level.

I note in said invoice that you have billed me with \$ 3400.00 as the price of said scow. According to my order placed with you under date February 2nd. last, and duly signed by myself and your Mr. Cossey, you will note that the price of said scow was to be between \$ 2500.00 and \$ 3000.00. Surely \$ 500.00 was sufficient leaway for your estimations. Under the circumstances therefore I feel that the extra \$ 400.00 on your invoice is aside from what was agreed upon, and I would ~~like~~ like to know just what you intend doing about it.

May I therefore expect a reply from you concerning this apparent overcharge as soon as it is conveniently possible.
